E. PRESIDENT UPDATE

- **Training for NJSLA** – The building principals can do in-person training for teaching staff or can ask for the teaching staff to view the GCN training. If members do the GCN training, then they do not have to attend the faculty meeting training on this topic. The principal can also decide to do a short 30-minute faculty meeting and then release staff to do the GCN training. Bottom line...this should not be done “in addition” to a faculty meeting
- **Instructional Assistants Training for NJSLA** – Some administration is indicating that our IAs have to complete the GCN training or attend the faculty meeting. FALSE! According to Dr. Boley, *“I will speak with each principal and let them know that they should do the training during the IA's workday. Nothing for them to do on their own time.”*
- **Injuries at Work** – If members are sustaining injuries at work due to student behavior, it is very important that they report the behavior to building administration and then visit the nurse for an assessment, so the nurse can record the injury. Please also take photographs of the injury and email Dana at EBEA575@hotmail.com with the information.
- **Part-Time to Full-Time** – Any part-time staff interested in full-time work should apply for ALL position postings. You MUST apply each time. Your application will be considered as the District wants to retain and reward dedicated employees. Your employment file will be reviewed. You will not be considered if you do not apply.
- **Child Nutrition Proclamation – April 20th at EBBOE meeting for “School Lunch Hero Day”** – We are encouraging our child nutrition staff to attend this meeting in their honor.
- **Building Visits** – I am making my rounds visiting buildings. I send out the information via district email about one week before I visit. I am there to answer questions on all topics and to chat with members about concerns.

F. GOVERNMENT RELATIONS [GR] (Chair Christopher Finnegan, EBEA.GR@gmail.com) –

- **State Aide** – thanks in large part to the efforts of NJEA members, the Legislature approved \$102 million in additional funding for districts that saw cuts to their state aid this year.
- **A-5060 (Reynolds Jackson, Lampitt, Verrelli, Stanley, McKnight, Jaffer)/S-3440 (Gopal)** – was introduced to update current sick leave laws for school employees. Four years ago, New Jersey joined a handful of other states to pass sick leave laws requiring time off for employees with sick family members or members dealing with domestic or sexual violence. There were exceptions to that law for unions covered by contracts or other state laws. However, your sick leave statute, which first passed in 1968, only covers your own illness. It does not, however, cover an illness for a family member. This bill updates the current law to allow employees to: use sick days for a family member's illness, for recovery from an employee's mental or physical illness, or for preventive medical care for the employee; for the employee to aid or care for a family member during their mental or physical illness; absence necessary due to circumstances resulting from the employee, or a family member of the employee, being a victim of domestic or sexual violence and circumstances surrounding getting help for such issues; the death of a family member for up to seven days; to attend a child's school-related conferences or meetings/functions; state of emergency, due to an epidemic or other public health emergency; exposure to a contagious disease or is quarantined (as well as the employee's immediate household). Members should contact their state representatives to support this bill either directly or from the Action Center on NJEA.org.
